SERVICES AND ACTIVITIES

Dupont Circle Village provides services through neighborhood volunteers. We also maintain a resource list of professionals in the area whose fees are reasonable. A coordinator connects requests with volunteers and providers, following up to ensure satisfaction.

Volunteer services currently include:

- Transportation to and from appointments & procedures
- Help with insurance & other forms
- Help with running errands
- Handyman chores
- Computer assistance
- Other electronics assistance

Recreational and social activities to date include walking, bridge, bike, and book groups.

Expansion of services: As Dupont Circle Village grows, we expect to

provide additional services and activities responding to the needs and requests of the membership. Possibilities include health programs, exercise groups, museum visits, and other social activities.
